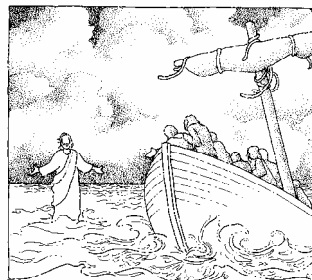
**Labor Day Mass**
