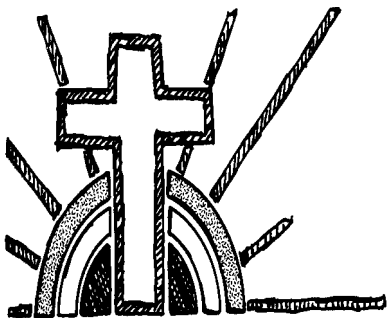
BOOK DISCUSSION

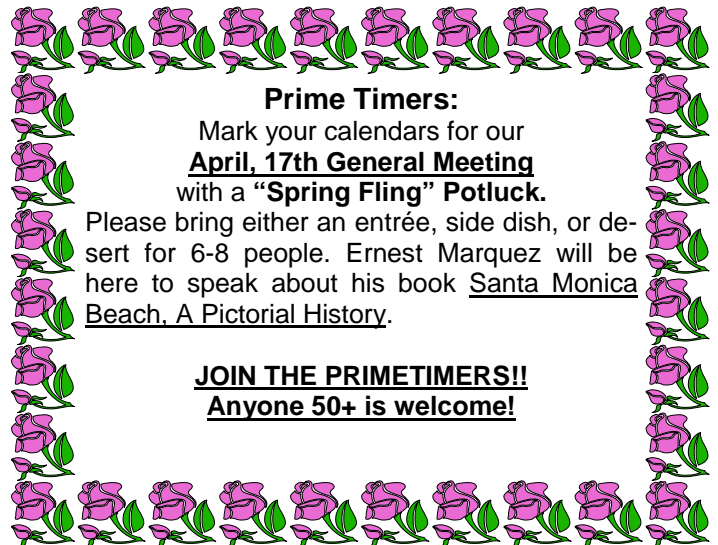
