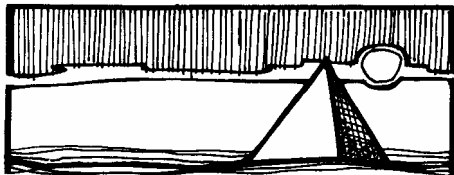

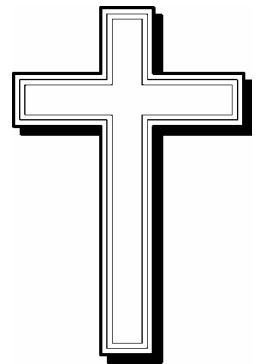


**Our next Senior Citizen Mass and Luncheon

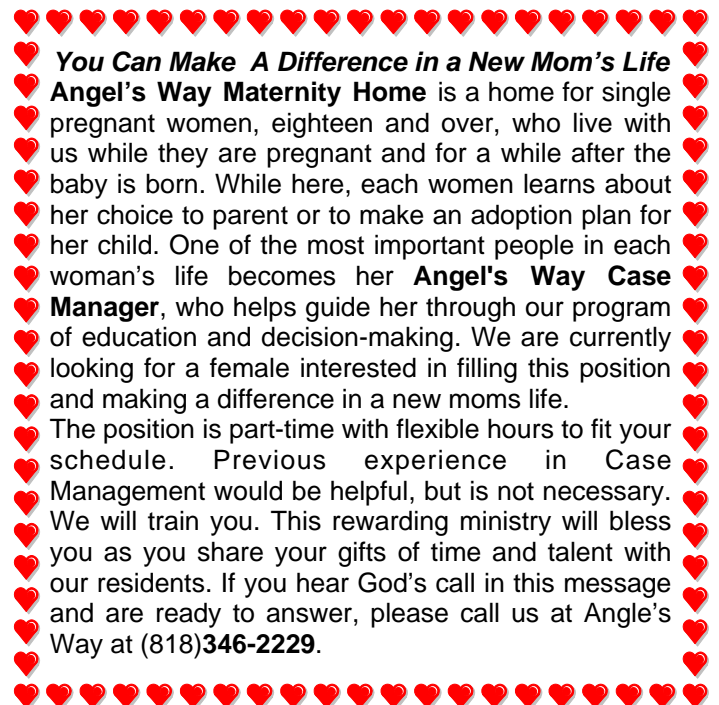

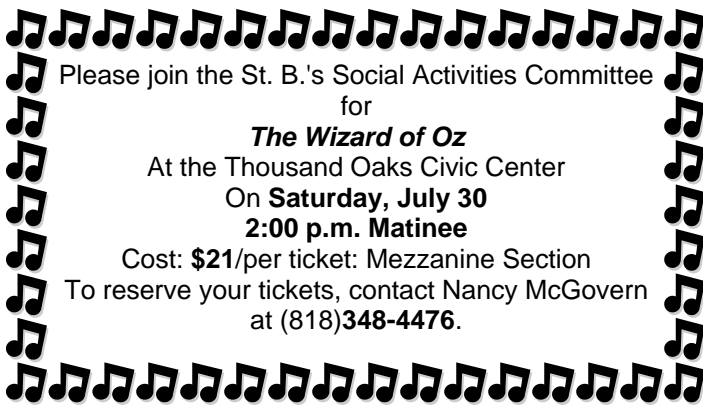
PRE-BAPTISM INSTRUCTION CLASS

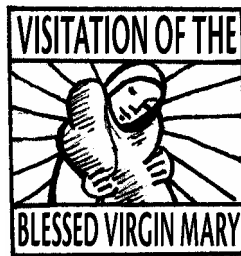
