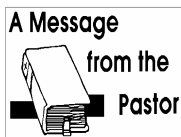

Today, throughout the Catholic world, is the feast of the Most Holy Trinity. While we are a monotheistic people, believing in one God, today's emphasis

Unlike "Going My Way" and the "Bells of St. Mary's" which we liked, the Da Vinci Code, masquerading as factual, does not present a true image of us Catholics. The first thing to note about this book and movie is of course that it is fiction. Dan Brown, the author, has been roundly criticized by historians, theologians, and art experts, each one pointing out his inaccuracies, falsehoods and downright lies. My sadness is that our Non-Catholic friends may forget it's fiction and think they are watching the History Channel. My hope is that the pamphlet I mailed you will help in a discussion at the "water cooler" and inspire you to research questions that arise. I confess that with all it's misinformation I enjoyed the book as a novel, the movie I found listless and dull.

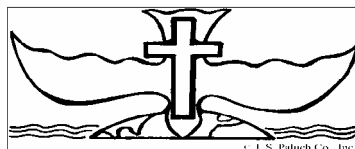

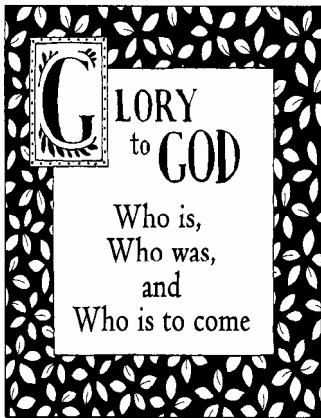
