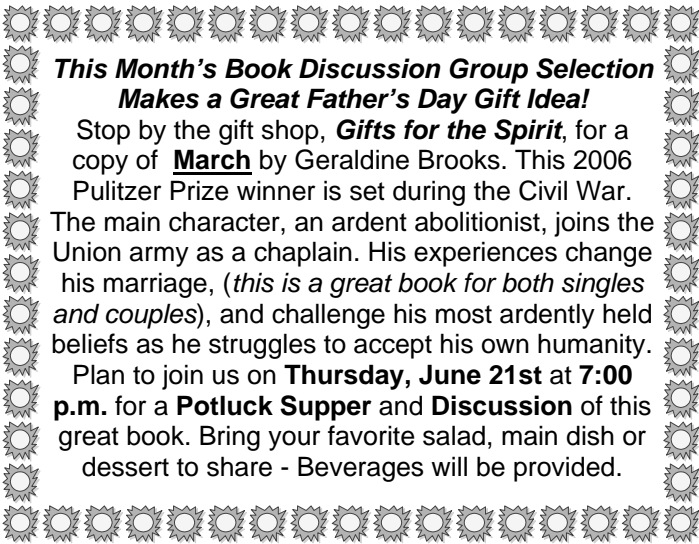
PRE-BAPTISM INSTRUCTION CLASS

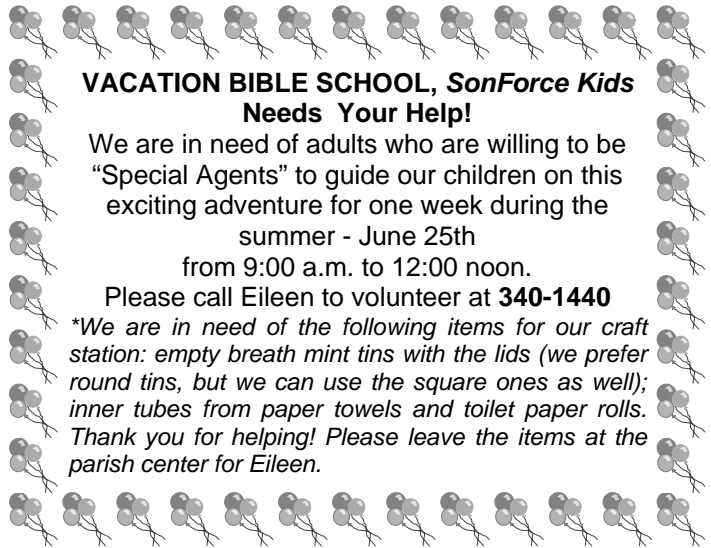
Summer Scripture Study

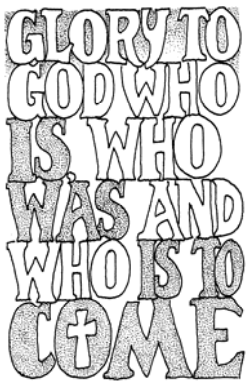
