


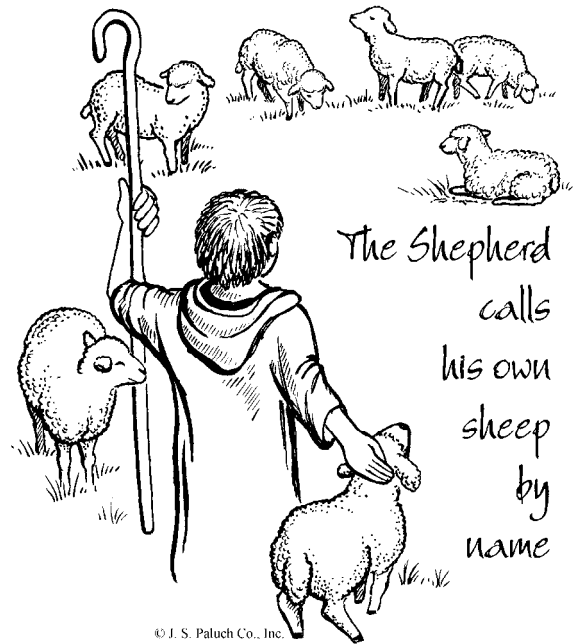

Your gift provides one-time emergency help to those in need for:

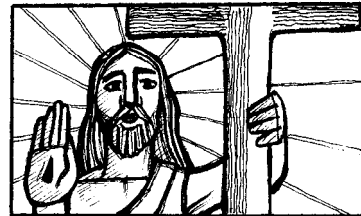

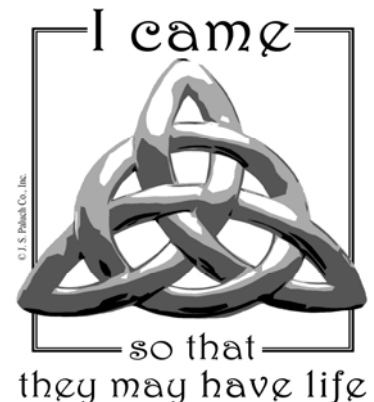
