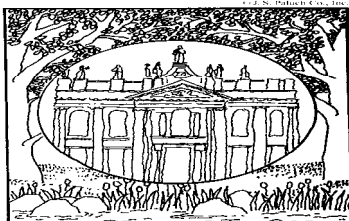
Dear Friends,

There were 54 funerals in our parish over the last twelve months. Their family members have been invited to our annual memorial Mass this **Friday at 7:30 pm**, but all parishioners are welcome to attend. It is a Mass for those who mourn and our prayers are very much for healing and comfort.

Catholic relief services is the official international humanitarian agency of the US Catholic community. 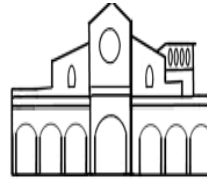

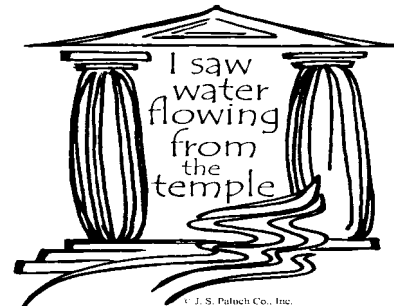

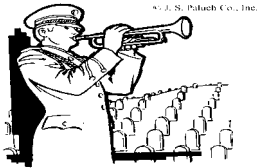
