May God our Father in heaven be your model, as you nurture, teach and protect your children. May your children also see in you great love for your wife and a Christian model of marriage.

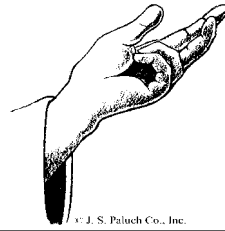

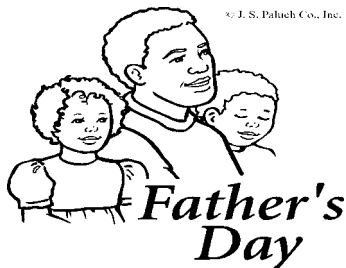
## The Life and Legacy of Cardinal Timothy Manning

Cardinal Timothy Manning served the Church of southern California for over 55 years. As Auxiliary Bishop and Archbishop of Los Angeles, he ordained 349 priests and confirmed approximately 650,000 people. June 23, 2009, marks the 20th anniversary of the death of this holy and faithful priest and servant of the Gospel.

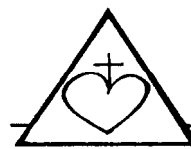
