The Catholic Church First 2000 years - Martha Rasmussen – A popular survey and comprehensive study guide to Church history.

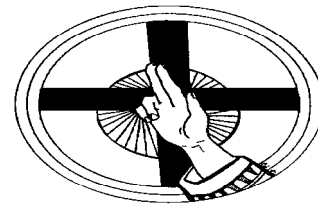

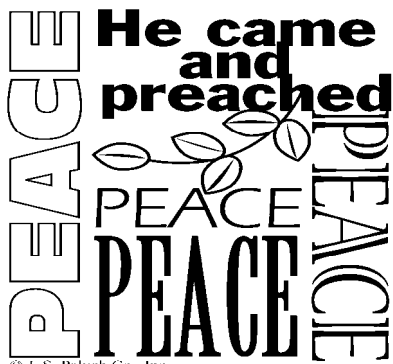

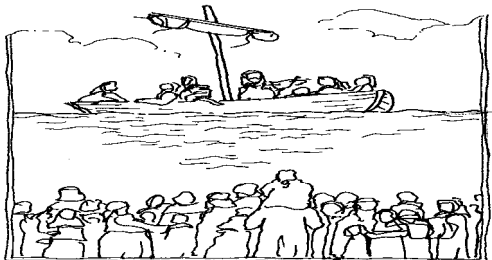

Fully 32 percent of online teens have been contacted by someone with no connection to them or any of their friends, and 7 percent of online teens say they have felt scared or uncomfortable as a result of contact by an online stranger. Although several factors are associated with high levels of stranger contact, the large majority of these interactions are benign. But to keep children safe from Internet predators, the LA City Attorney's Office offers a variety of age-appropriate Internet Safety presentations.

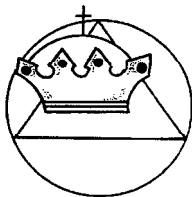
