C.S. Lewis taught at Oxford and Cambridge and was familiarly known as 'Jack'. He corresponded with men and women of all backgrounds and his letters offer spiritual direction for all people who struggle with dilemmas of faith and doubt, romance, tragedy, illness and loss.

Paul Ford's recent book, Yours, Jack: Spiritual Direction from C.S. Lewis is a selection of those letters.
